- **Online Giving**

A great way to give is by utilizing online giving! All information concerning contributions made to Church of Hope is held in the strictest confidence. Any information you provide in the process of making a contribution via Church of Hope's website is maintained securely in our database. This information will remain private and will never be sold or otherwise shared with third parties except to process your contribution.

You can give a one-time gift or schedule giving to occur automatically based on the schedule you choose. You may schedule new online contribution at any time and modify or cancel those contribution prior to the date for which they are scheduled. Once the contribution has been processed, it cannot be cancelled. Please be aware that for online contributions given via credit or debit card, Church of Hope will typically be charged a 2.5% to 3.5% card processing fee.

Year End Contribution Statements

Your Giving History is available online throughout the year, through Fellowship One, the Church's web based record keeping program.

If you are already giving online or have established an account, all you need to do is go to our website, www.HopeInOcala.com, click on the "Give" tab, then click on the "View Giving History" tab, sign in to your account, select "Your Giving" then select the year, click "View", then click "Download Statement," and finally, click the print icon on the Adobe banner. You can use the same procedure to view previous years.

If you have not yet established an online account, go into our website, www.HopeInOcala.com, click on the "Give" tab, then click on the "View Giving History" tab, then click "Sign Up" in the bottom right hand corner to create an account with your own personal password. **Note: You do not have to participate in online giving to view your contributions.** Once you are logged into the online giving section, click on the "Your Giving" and follow the instructions above.

Church of Hope is a nonprofit organization under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code. All contributions to Church of Hope are tax deductible to the extent allowed by law. Consult your tax advisor if you have any questions about the deductibility of your contributions.

Church of Hope adopts a Biblical plan for financial matters. All funds contributed to the church by partners or others are for general operations; gifts must fulfill the mission and discipleship process of the church and cannot be designated by the donor in accordance with the Internal Revenue Service Tax code. All contributions shall be deposited to the credit of the church and disbursed to fulfill the mission of Church of Hope—partnering with people to discover in Christ we have Hope!
